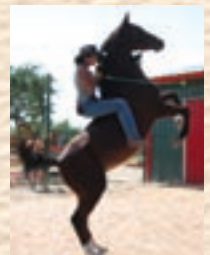
### **Dressage Clinic**

Clinician Bobby Richards will show three different shoeing methods and how the weight and angle of the shoe effects the animation and stride using the same Tennessee Walking Horse. He will begin with a light shod shoe and show the animation and gait. Re-shoeing the same horse with a Park Pleasure shoe he will demonstrate the increased animation and lengthening of stride. He will then replace the Park Pleasure shoe with a built up shoe demonstrating the increased stride and head shake.
